Measuring for your Replacement Windows and Patio Doors

Deduct 1/2" from the smallest daylight opening width then and height, this allows 1/4" clearance all the way around the new window. Patio doors should be measured with the old sill removed, keeping the original side jambs and top (head).

HEIGHT



DIAGONAL



MEASURE 3 PLACES ON WIDTH & HEIGHT

1. Measure top, center and bottom on width.
2. Measure left, center and right on height
3. Measure your diagonal, if more than 1/2" difference between left and right, deduct an additional 1/8" from the longest of the two (width or height) dimensions.

All dimensions given to American Integrity must be width first then height (WXH). All handing of windows are from the outside looking into the building. American Integrity is not responsible for accuracy of these measurements, please consult a Dealer of Integrity for further instructions.
